- **Common Entrance Test (CET 2023-24)**

A Common Entrance Test procedure will be adopted for admission to first year Program at the affiliated colleges and University Department for following subject

- **Master of Social Work (M.S.W.)**

- **Admission Process agencies:-**

a) Application Receipt Center (ARC) –Following Centers will be responsible for-

- 1) Collection of the Application form printout and necessary documents along with **receipt of online payment** as attached with form.
- 2) Issuing Receipt Acknowledgement slip
- 3) Verification of documents submitted by the candidate and inwarding the application form online.

Student will have to fill up online form as available on the university website <http://www.nmu.ac.in>, a form will be generated for the students applying for CET. Student should take print out of the computer generated form, receipt of online payment and attach attested photocopies of necessary documents. **While filling the online application form, the Application fee of Rs.600/- should be paid online through the given payment gateway and receipt of online payment** should be attached with the application form for the CET. Forms should be submitted to the ARC (University Department / Social Work Colleges) as prescribed above in brochure. After submitting the form, **candidate should collect the Acknowledgement Receipt Slip from ARC.**

- **It is mandatory to appear for CET for admission to the above mentioned Program.**
- **Eligibility Criteria :**

Candidates appeared for **any Bachelor's Degree** from recognized University.

A **Bachelor's Degree** of minimum of 3 years duration or its equivalent (under the 10+2+3 or 10+2+2+1 year bridge course pattern of study or any pattern fulfilling the mandatory requirement of 15 years formal education).

The minimum requirement for admission to the M.S.W. PG degree programme is **Bachelor's Degree in Social Work, Arts, Science, Commerce, Law, Home Science, or any other faculty or a recognized University with a minimum of 45 % marks.** Higher academic degrees or diplomas in Social Sciences and experience of working with people will be an additional qualification.

• **Reservations :-**

All the reservations given below shall be applicable to candidates belonging to Maharashtra state government only subject to the fulfillment of the eligibility criteria specified by respective authorities from time to time.

(a) **Reservation for backward class category candidates:**

The percentage of seats reserved for candidates of backward class categories belonging to Maharashtra state is as given below. The percentage of reservation is the percentages of the seats available for Maharashtra candidates, coming under the CET. Backward class candidates shall claim the category to which they belong to at the time of submission of application form for CET.

(b) **Reservation for wards of Defence service personnel:**

Five % percent (5%) seats out of total sanctioned intake capacity of university schools and affiliated colleges as a whole separately, subject to a maximum of one (01) seat in each institute coming under CET shall be reserved for wards of ex- service personnel who are from Maharashtra state.

(c) **Reservation for persons with disability candidates:**

Five percent (5%) seats of total sanctioned intake capacity of university schools and affiliated colleges as a whole separately, subject to a maximum of one (01) seat in each institute coming under CET shall be reserved for candidates with disability.

The allotment of seats reserved for the candidates with disability shall be done on the basis of merit. The candidates claiming reservation under this category shall submit the Physical Disability certificates.

Note: -Candidates with disability should note that on admission to degree course they will not be given any exemptions or additional facility in the academic activities other than those which may be provided by the university.

(d) If the reservation quota remains vacant then 2% seats of total intake capacity of university schools and affiliated colleges as a whole separately will be offered to SBC category.

(e) Reservation for EWS (Economical Weaker Section) Candidate: As per the provisions in Government Resolution No. राआधो-4019/ह.ड.31/16-अ, dated 12th February, 2019, 10% seats shall be reserved for EWS candidates. These seats shall be filled by the Competent Authority through CET as per the policies of the Government declared from time to time.

(f) If sufficient candidates from Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University area are not available for admission for such program, candidates from other universities will be considered. Similarly, if candidates from other universities are not available for admission, the candidates from Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University will be considered for admission. There will be separate merit list for other university students.

(g) Any change from Government side in terms of reservation before the commencement of CET Round -I will be taken under consideration.

(h) Candidate once admitted through industry sponsored quota will not be allowed to shift to general quota under any circumstances.

- **Candidates graduated from Social Work discipline (BSW) 50 % Seat Reserve.**
- Candidates graduated from Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon..... **70 %**
- Candidates graduated from other University (Out of Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University)..... **30 %**

• **Deputed Candidates:**

Candidates being deputed by Government or private Organization should apply through proper channel with appropriate NOC. Direct application shall not consider.

- **Common Entrance Test Details:** (Written Test held on 27/7/2023 Time:11.00am to 12.00pm)

The Entrance Test will consist of:

- The mode of Common Entrance Test (**Written Test Exam**) will be offline in the form of **OMR Sheet**.
 - The question paper will be consisting of only **objective type questions**.
 - Each question has four options out of each only one is correct.
 - **Written Test Exam consists of single paper of 60 minutes (One hour) duration that contains 50 questions carrying maximum of 100 Marks.**
 - Candidate should dark in the entire circle.
 - **Use black ball point pen for darkening the circle.**

- **Stages of Common Entrance Test (MSW CET 2023-24)**

Stage I: Prerequisites –

- Read the instructions given in brochure carefully
- Before proceeding for filling up the admission form ensure the following
 - (a) Visit the link <http://nmu.ac.in>
 - (b) Fill up the online application form as per the given instruction.
 - (c) **While filling the online application form, the Application fee of Rs.600/- should be paid online through the given payment gateway.**
 - (d) After submitting the online form. Form Number will be generated by the system.
- **Please Note the Form No. For future reference.**
- Print the Application Form and attach the attested photocopies of necessary documents along with the receipt of online payment, paste your passport size recent photograph on application and submit the completed form to the nearby ARC (Social work College /Department) by hand or send it by post super scribing “Application for CET for admission to <<Course Name >>”to the Principal & Head of the Department of the concerned ARC Social Work Colleges, application form should reach to ARC on or before **23 July 2023.**
- In case of any discrepancy /deficiency in the application form/attached documents you are required to comply the deficiencies to the concerned ARC before the last date of submission of application form.

Stage -II: Display of eligible candidates list of for Common Entrance Test:

- The list of eligible candidates for appearing to CET will be available on the website and will also be displayed on the notice board of the respective Social Work ARC.
- The list of eligible candidates for appearing to CET will not be published in any newspaper or will not be communicated to any candidate personally by post.

- If the candidate has any objection related with the merit list he/she may submit his/her objection with proper documents in written form to the Kavaytri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University by Fax No. 0257-2258406 or through email cet@nmu.ac.in within Specified date and time limit.
